How to find us

Thame Community Hospital is located on East Street, Thame.

By Road:

From Aylesbury: Take the A418 signposted Oxford – follow the A418, past Hartwell House (on right) through Stone for approximately 15 minutes. At the large roundabout, take 1st exit marked Princes Risborough. At small roundabout, take 3rd exit marked Thame. Go straight across at mini roundabout. Thame Community Hospital can be found approximately 100 yards on left-hand side.

Public Transport:

Trains: The closest train station is Haddenham & Thame Parkway and is a 10 minute drive from the hospital.

Bus Routes: Bus routes 40, 73, 110, 113, 120 and 340 stop just outside the hospital on East Street. Route 280 operates between Aylesbury and Thame (at least every 30 minutes) and stops on Thame High Street, which is a 10-12 minute walk from the hospital.

From Oxford: take A40 Oxford to London Road. From the A40, take the Thame turn-off (this is also the turning for the services). Follow signs to Thame / Thame town centre. Proceed through town centre, across 2 mini roundabouts (bypassing all shops). At 3rd mini roundabout, turn left on East Street. Thame Community Hospital is approximately 200 yards on the right-hand side.

Parking:

The main car park, including disabled parking bays, can be found towards the rear left of the hospital building. There is additional limited parking and disabled parking directly in front of the main entrance. There are also limited parking spaces available on the main public road.
